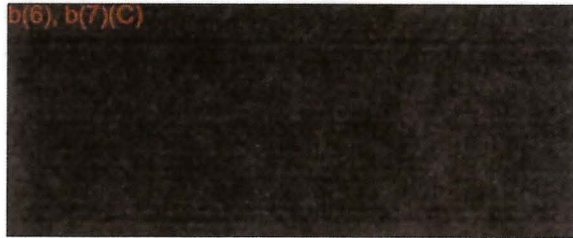
certifications, the Government believes that a brief extension of time would be of great benefit in preparing a complete and accurate response to the Court's Briefing Order.
