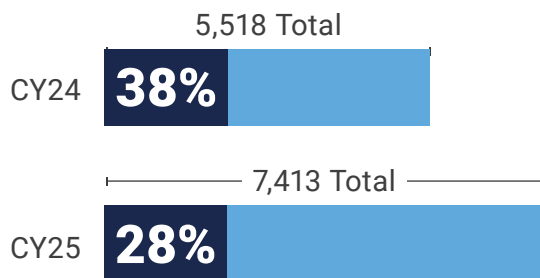

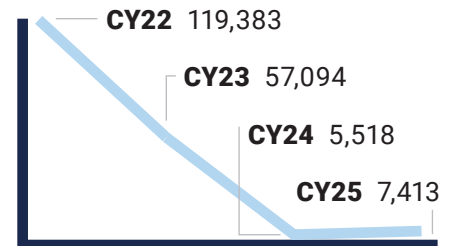
Percentage of U.S. Person

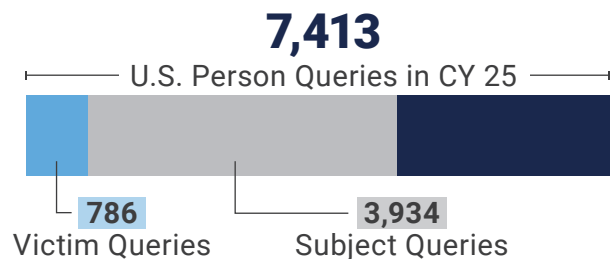


Number of U.S. Person queries

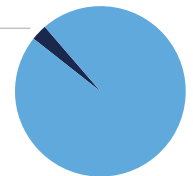


Number of U.S. Person queries that

Enhanced Accountability

In 2023, the FBI implemented Query Accountability Procedures (QAPs) to identify, evaluate and remediate query-related compliance incidents. RISAA codified the QAPs. DOJ's NSD reports every non-compliant incident to the FISC and to Congress, and any FBI personnel involved with such incidents immediately have their access to raw FISA information suspended pending further review per the QAP. Any compliance incident assessed to potentially be a result of intentional misconduct is referred to FBI's Inspection Division for further review. The FBI's compliance matters are reported to Congress in the Annual Query Accountability Report.
