1. SIGNIFICANCE:

THIS BRIEFING BOARD PORTRAYS A LACK OF LOGISTICS ACTIVITY AT TRANS-SHIPMENT POINTS IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF QUANG KHE DURING THE 1968 TET TRUCE.

2. LOCATION:

THE TRANSSHIPMENT POINTS ARE LOCATED ALONG BOTH BANKS OF THE SONG GIANG (RIVER) JUST NORTH OF QUANG KHE AND SEVENTY-THREE NM SOUTHEAST OF VINH, NORTH VIETNAM.

3. BACKGROUND:

THE TRANSSHIPMENT POINTS ON THE SONG GIANG AT QUANG KHE, NORTH VIETNAM, WERE THE SITE OF CONSIDERABLE ACTIVITY DURING THE 1967 TET TRUCE AND DURING THE 1967-68 CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR TRUCE PERIODS.

DURING THE 1967 TET TRUCE, 8 THROUGH 11 FEBRUARY 1967, NUMEROUS WATER-BORNE LOGISTICS CRAFT (INCLUDING SL-1 -SIGHTED FOR THE FIRST TIME IN NORTH VIETNAM) ACCOUNTED FOR A MAJOR PORTION OF THE LOGISTICS EFFORT. HOWEVER, NO LARGE WATER-BORNE LOGISTICS CRAFT WERE OBSERVED AT QUANG KHE DURING THE 1967-68 CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR TRUCE PERIOD.

DURING THE 1967-68 CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR TRUCES SUPPLIES WERE OB-SERVED BEING BROUGHT SOUTH ALONG ROUTE LA BY CARGO TRUCKS, TRANSPORTED
