THE DAYTIME USE OF THE HA NOI/VINH RAILLINE WAS OBSERVED DURING THE 1967 CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR TRUCE PERIODS. LORRY-PULLED SUPPLY TRAINS TOOK ADVANTAGE OF THE CESSATION OF BOMBING TO SHUTTLE MATERIAL BETWEEN THANH HOA AND VINH. SEVERAL SUPPLY TRAINS PULLED BY STEAM LOCOMOTIVES WERE SIGHTED ON THE THANH HOA/NINH BINH SEGMENT DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS OF THE 1967-68 NEW YEAR TRUCE.

THE DAY TIME SIGHTINGS OF SUPPLY TRAINS PRIOR TO THE 1968 TET TRUCE
WERE UNUSUAL AND PROBABLY REPRESENTED A STRONGER AND BOLDER EFFORT BY
THE NORTH VIETNAMESE TO INCREASE THE FLOW OF MATERIALS BY RAIL.
